Covenant Class

MPC Education Grants Available

The MPC Education Foundation is now accepting applications for grants to be awarded this fall. Any member of MPC who is 1) a graduating high school senior and has been accepted by a two year or four year institute of higher education, or 2) a person enrolling in a Presbyterian Seminary for a degree in the ministry or Christian education is eligible.

Grants are determined on the basis of experiences, leadership, and church and community involvement. The amounts awarded will be determined by the funds available from the MPC Education Endowment.

Applications are available in the narthex or the church office. Please submit completed applications, along with two reference letters and high school or college transcripts to the church office by May 27, 2008.

Under the Radar

Gina Phelps grew up in the Church of the Brethren. Her college education was at Virginia Tech and Radford. She met her husband Brian at a volleyball tournament at Raphine in August 1993 and by November they were married. They lived in Roanoke and, looking for a church they could both attend comfortably, they found Raleigh Court Presbyterian Church. Collier and Betsy Harvey shared in the life of that congregation and became good friends with the young couple. Their children Logan and Megan were born and Gina took her natural place working in the nursery at Raleigh Court.

In 2001 Brian purchased a business here and the young family moved north. They were beginning to check out churches in this area and proceeded no farther than their first stop, MPC, where they were delighted to find their old friends the Harveys. In what happened next one can trace the emergence of a calling in Gina's life. Never one to sit on her hands, Gina jumped right in, working in the kitchen for Logos meetings, then teaching the pre-school group in the Logos program. That led to volunteering at the Massanutten Pre-school program --and that in turn led to her employment as a teacher of 3-year-olds at the MPC Pre-school. To become better skilled at that, Gina returned to school and earned a Master's degree in Early Childhood Education at JMU.

She took part in Vacation Bible School, starting out as a helper, and eventually becoming director one year. Until recently she taught in children's church. She served one year on the Session's Property Committee. She has also helped Brian with some of his projects, such as the turkey feathers at Thanksgiving time. Most recently, she has enjoyed teaching in the Faith Village program. For outside interests, Gina enjoys reading, particularly mysteries.

Concerning her church, Gina appreciates the feeling of closeness she has with others in the congregation. "Since I don't have any other family here except my own, I feel as if they are my family. And I'm grateful that my kids feel they're at home in this place." In the midst of the bubble of a busy life constantly punctuated by energetic children, she finds at MPC that it is indeed possible to find an equilibrium between life outside and life inside the church. Thanks, Gina, for realizing your calling and giving yourself to it in so many ways!
